
Benefits not found with traditional braces

We've observed benefits for Invisalign patients not found with the use of traditional braces. Here are 5 ways clear aligners make your life easier during treatment:

01 Removable Design

This benefit seems apparent, but think about the difference. Metal braces attach to the teeth throughout treatment, but aligners can be popped out any time for eating and cleaning. While wires snag chunks of lettuce, aligners keep you eating normally. Plus, you can brush and floss like you normally do without trying to work around lots of hardware. Aligners worn 22 hours each day will move your teeth as predicted, so a couple of hours of freedom makes life a lot easier.



02 Excellent Comfort



Discomfort from braces results for a couple of reasons. First, metal pieces rubbing against fragile cheeks and lips may create sores and cuts. Second, the pressure generated by wires and elastics pushes on teeth with significant force, leaving many patients unable to chew normally for a few days after a visit. By contrast, the smooth, polished surface of the medical-grade plastic used for aligners is relatively easy for the tongue and cheeks to tolerate. And since you switch to a new aligner every two weeks, the amount of force applied to the teeth at one time is more subtle.



04 Short Treatment Time


There's no guarantee that Invisalign works faster than braces, but many cases finish up in half the time! Models of your teeth are scanned into a sophisticated CAD software program developed in the Silicon Valley. With the help of the proprietary program and Invisalign's technicians, our doctor analyzes the predicted course of treatment. Modifications to increase the efficiency of tooth movement are built into the case at the beginning, providing a pre-programmed course of treatment. This helps shorten treatment time, with an average duration of one year in many cases.

Easy Maintenance and Follow-up

With braces, brackets pop loose and wires break. A few extra visits for repairs during treatment are usually added to the schedule. With Invisalign, minimal maintenance is needed, and periodic check-up visits don't take long. Also, retainers after treatment look similar to Invisalign aligners. So popping retainers in at night already fits the routine and mindset of Invisalign patients. And consistent retention protects every orthodontic case.
